# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

With the fluid COVID-19 situation and the many changes needed for personal safety and well-being, SAE International is established a comprehensive risk mitigation protocol for all in-person events in the Pre-Professional Education division. ## 2. ATTENDANCE & PARTICIPATION

RIT has COVID protocols in place currently that must be followed.

1. All students and advisors must be fully vaccinated to enter the facility. This includes:
  - Gordon Field House: SAE Registration, Technical Inspection, Design Event and Awards Banquet
  - Ingle Auditorium: Sales Event Finals
2. Individuals are considered fully vaccinated:
  - Two weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series (such as Pfizer or Moderna vaccines); or Two weeks after a single-dose vaccine (such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine)
3. Vaccination verification:
  - Volunteers will be set up outside the Gordon Field House to log vaccination status on Thursday and Friday. There will be no vaccination check on Saturday or Sunday. **Anyone attending the banquet must have vaccination status verified on Thursday or Friday.**
  - RIT staff will issue a wristband which must remain on your wrist for the entire event.
4. Proof of vaccination:
  - Photo ID with a full, legal name that matches either a vaccination card (actual or digital images of front and back) or valid New York State Excelsior Pass
  - Vaccination card showing vaccinations as described
5. Negative test results are not an acceptable substitute for proof of full vaccination.
6. Vaccination is not mandatory for attendance of competition, but you will not be allowed in any RIT facilities if unvaccinated.

There are no COVID protocols for Hogback Hill.

SAE International requirement to sign COVID liability waiver is still required by all volunteers, sponsors, and student team members. Signing this waiver indicates individual is aware of the inherent risks associated with in-person events and verifying they have not tested positive or shown symptoms for COVID-19 in the 14 days prior to competition regardless of vaccination status.
