SITE ACCESS

Absolutely NO early site access. Enter site from Trico Road only, no other entry points will be allowed. We strongly advise that teams access the site from I-10 via Pinal Airpark Road. There are other access routes but they all require multiple turns, stops signs etc. not ideal for trailers.

Do not block the site entrance prior to the opening time on any day to ensure all volunteers and sponsors can arrive without any issue.

If a team chooses to arrive prior to 8am on Thursday they should stage along Hardin Road only. Do not stage along Trico Road as it is narrow and just north of the event site is an active construction project. It is the team's responsibility to determine the best area to stage, turn around, etc. on Hardin road.

This year we are fortunate to have the Team Pit area directly adjacent to the normal vehicle parking area so teams that are binging water, food etc. for use in their pits will have a short walk. Please follow all signs and volunteer directions when loading in the trailers and do not ask to follow your trailer vehicle to drop anything off.

FACILITY INFORMATION

The event site is part of a large multi-use facility that includes numerous buildings and areas and is located on a working farm. The event areas and buildings that we will be using will be clearly marked. Please stay within the event boundaries and **do not wander on to other areas of the property**. The facility owners have been very helpful and supportive of this event, please do not do anything to jeopardize our relationship with them. Please, please, please keep your pit areas tidy and pick up your trash, we will have plenty of trashcans and a dumpster easily accessible.

Note there are several drainage ditches used to transport water within the boundaries of our competition area, use caution around them. Additionally, there may be farm equipment driving or working during the competition, please stay away from any working equipment. All students should keep out of the dynamic areas on Thursday and Friday as course prep may still be going on.

- Absolutely NO smoking on site
- Absolutely NO alcohol on site
- Cooking/grilling anywhere on site is not allowed
