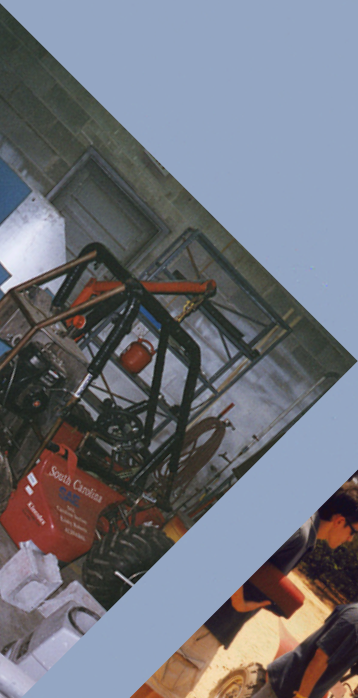

The SAE® Carolina Section is proud to welcome you to the 2025 Baja SAE® Carolina Competition! We're excited to host you here in South Carolina, the birthplace of Baja SAE®.

The very first event (then called *Mini Baja East*) was held in 1976 at the University of South Carolina. That inaugural competition marked the beginning of what would become SAE International®'s Collegiate Design Series. A generation later, the University of South Carolina also hosted the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of Baja SAE®.

This year is especially meaningful: together, we're kicking off the 50th anniversary year of Baja SAE® right here where it all began. Over five decades, Baja SAE® has grown into one of the largest and most prestigious engineering competitions in the world; an event that continues to inspire innovation, teamwork, and real-world learning.

We are honored to carry on this rich tradition with all of you. Inside this event guide, you'll find everything you need to make your experience smooth and memorable, including site access, schedules, and resources.



## Fun Facts about the Baja SAE® Competition

---

- **Where it started:** The first Baja SAE® was held in 1976 at the University of South Carolina (USC), organized by mechanical engineering professor John F. Stephens. His vision was to create a hands-on project that combined classroom theory with real-world challenges, such as manufacturability, cost, and time constraints.
- **Humble beginnings:** That first event hosted just 10 universities and 90 students, including teams from USC, Arizona State, and NC State. Today, Baja SAE® has grown to three competitions each year across the U.S., under the leadership of SAE International®.
- **Milestone moments:** The 25th anniversary was also celebrated at USC, making this year's return to South Carolina especially fitting as we begin the 50th anniversary celebration.

## Fun Facts about the state of South Carolina

---

- **State symbol:** The palmetto is South Carolina's state tree—even though it isn't technically a tree (its trunk is fibrous, not solid wood).
- **Tea & tradition:** The Palmetto State is home to America's first commercial tea farm and the birthplace of sweet tea, often called our "hospitality beverage." (But the official state drink is actually milk!)
- **Golf capital:** South Carolina boasts some of the world's best golf courses—and Myrtle Beach holds the title of "Mini Golf Capital of the World," with over 50 courses.
- **Natural wonders:** The Angel Oak Tree on Johns Island is believed to be the oldest living thing east of Mississippi.
- **Industry power:** Spartanburg is home to the largest BMW plant in the world, and South Carolina is also a top global exporter of tires, thanks to companies like Michelin, Bridgestone, and Continental.
- **Peach state rivalry:** South Carolina harvests more peaches than Georgia!
- **Motorsports connection:** Just north of the border, North Carolina is the Stock Car Racing Capital of the World. On your way home, don't miss the NASCAR Hall of Fame or a visit to a NASCAR team.
- **Team spirit:** The NFL Carolina Panthers' logo is shaped to outline both North and South Carolina, since both states share the team

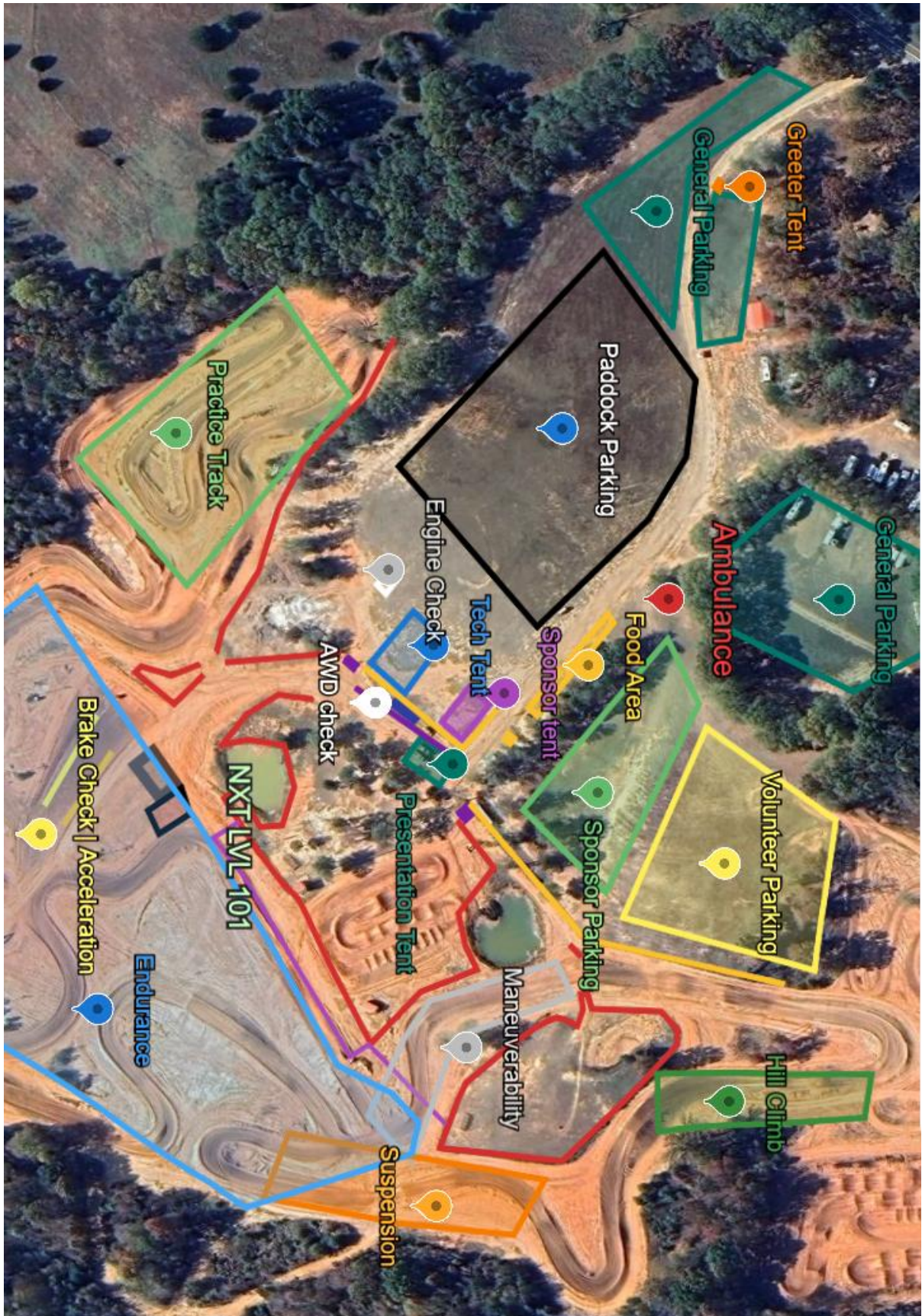

# Site Access, Arrival, and Traffic Instruction

---

**Arrival & Traffic Instructions:** For everyone's safety, the South Carolina Highway Patrol requires all teams to use the designated route below—even if your GPS suggests something else. Officers will be at key intersections to guide traffic, and teams using this route will get priority.

## Directions to Facility:

- Take **I-385 Exit 16 (SC-101)**.
- Follow **SC-101** for about **1.7 miles** to Gray Court.
- At the traffic light, go **straight across** and over the railroad tracks.
- Turn **right** onto **W. Main St.**
- Drive **0.4 miles** to the 4-way stop and turn **left** back onto **SC-101**.
- Stay on SC-101 for **5.4 miles**, then turn **left into 14499 SC-101** (the facility entrance).

## Important:

- **Do NOT block** the entrance before opening times
- **Do NOT park outside the facility and walk in.** This can lead to **team disqualification**
- Law enforcement will ticket vehicles parked on the roadside or “cruising” the area

## Parking & Paddock Rules:

- Follow all **signs** and **volunteer directions** when unloading trailers
- Only **competition vehicles (after tech inspection)** and **official vehicles** may drive in the paddock
- No exceptions for “just dropping something off”

## Pre-Paddock Parking (Wednesday ONLY):

- **Available Wednesday, October 30, 4:00 – 6:00 PM local time**
- **Do NOT** arrive earlier as you will be turned away. No roadside waiting allowed.
- Once your trailer is parked, your team must leave by 6:00 PM local time (overnight security will be provided).
- No one is allowed on-site after 6:00 PM local time

## Trailer & Tow Vehicle Rules:

- If your trailer and tow vehicle don't fit together, the tow vehicle must park in the General Parking area or another designated area
- Bring wheel chocks with you (keep them in the tow vehicle) for safe parking
- If you need to remove your trailer:
  1. This can only be done **between 6:00 and 6:30 PM local time**, and you must arrange it with **SAE® staff in advance**
  2. The trailer must return to the **same paddock spot** the next morning at **7:00 AM local time**
  3. Once your vehicle has passed **tech inspection**, neither the trailer nor the vehicle may be removed

## Facility Rules

---

- **No animals** are allowed on site
- **No alcohol, drugs, tobacco, or vaping** anywhere at the facility
- **Closed-toe shoes required** – no sandals, flip-flops, or similar
- Stay inside event boundaries; **do not enter adjacent property**
- No climbing on fences, hay bales, dirt piles, or entering ponds
- **Keep paddock areas clean.** Dispose of trash properly and daily
- No driving in the paddock except by certified competition vehicles or official organizer vehicles

## Food & Amenities

---

- **Food trucks** will be on site daily for food purchases at the competition. These are independent operators, and they set their own menus and costs
- **Coffee truck** will be on site each day. Independent operator
- **Grilling area** is available outside of the paddock area

## Weather

---

For the first week of October in Gray Court, South Carolina, expect mild and pleasant autumn weather. Average high temperatures are typically in the upper 60s to high 70s, with average lows falling to the upper 40s to mid-50s overnight. Rainfall is generally moderate for the month, so be prepared for the possibility of some showers. Be sure to check your favorite weather app as the event approaches. Late summer heat waves can sneak up on us. Stay safe by drinking plenty of water throughout the day.

## Safety & Conduct

---

**All participants are expected to act with professionalism, show respect to others, and proudly represent their universities and/or companies. Misconduct, unsafe actions, or breaking event rules may result in penalties, disqualification, or removal from the site.**
