

Addendum Issued: 27 January 2023

Reason: For the 2023 competition season, during rules committee discussions the Business Presentation Event planned to request video submissions. However, during the development of concept and process the committee decided from an equity and judging resource perspective to make the submission a simple written document. SAE missed the step of revising the rules during Rev B release.

Below are the changes to the rules for 2023, these rules are in effect for this year's competition and will be revised for the 2024 rules.

In addition to this minor rules' addendum, teams should already be referencing the 2023 Baja SAE Business Presentation Event Description and Guideline document for guidance on how to complete the required submission.

C5.5 – Format

BP will operate in a hybrid model consisting of a video Request For Proposal (RFP) submission, virtual presentations, and onsite finals presentations.

C.5.5.1 - Virtual Presentations

All teams will submit a pre-recorded Request For Proposal (RFP) video submission to the Baja SAE website. BP judges will review all submissions and choose a portion of submissions to present live in the virtual presentations round. All details on submission format, length, content, and timing will be published on the Baja SAE website.

C.5.5.2 - Onsite Presentations

Teams selected from the video RFP submission will virtually present their BP to a panel of judges and their score will apply to all onsite competitions they are attending. Teams will be ranked only against teams attending the same competition. The software platform for virtual presentations will be defined and communicated by the organizing body. The virtual presentations will take place before any onsite events. Student teams may be required to submit a judge pre-read document ahead of their presentation. If so, teams will be notified ahead of time on the deadline and format.
